



  - Fusarium Head Blight in wheat and barley



# Governor's Recommendation

- Increase Operating: \$1,200,000
- Increase in FTE: \$310,000
  - Faculty (2)
    - Potato Pathologist (Pale Cyst Nematode Eradication & Mgmt.)
    - Barley Agronomist
  - Technical Support Staff (2)
    - Potato Pathology
    - Barley Agronomy
- Increase in Health Benefits: \$414,000
