Starting Point


These are the 4 strategies proposed from the committee 3 months ago (prior to public hearings):

1. Design a reliable, multi-measure, and transparent **accountability system** that clearly measures student growth; excellence is recognized and replicated, improvement is continuous, and failure is remedied (Structural Change Committee)
2. With the goal of optimizing the individual outcomes of students, create a **flexible model that drives decision making and empowerment to lowest practical level**; engage parents (Structural Change Committee)
3. Create structure and incentives to provide **collaboration and innovation** to drive continuous improvement of high performance (Structural Change Committee)
4. Implement **technology** to provide tools **to increase student achievement** (Technology Committee)
