

Definition

- ▶ Graduate Medical Education (GME) is training completed after medical school allowing medical school graduates to become licensed physicians eligible for board certification in a given specialty
- ▶ Licensing and board certification are usually necessary for hospital privileges and payment from insurance



Definition

- ▶ Residency and fellowship education make up graduate medical education (GME)
- ▶ Residency lasts between 3 – 7 years depending on the specialty
- ▶ Fellowship occurs after residency allowing for sub-specialization
- ▶ Fellowships vary in length depending on the sub-specialty



Resident Training (GME) is Different from Medical Student Education

Accreditation

- ▶ American Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) is the accrediting body
- ▶ 24 specialties each with a Residency Review Committee
- ▶ Each Residency Review Committee is composed of physicians in that given specialty



Accreditation

- ▶ RRC sets standards which then define curriculum and learning objectives taught in a given specialty during residency and fellowship
- ▶ Institutional requirements directed towards sponsoring institutions are set by the ACGME
- ▶ ACGME program site visits every 2 – 5 years



Financing

- ▶ Cost is ~\$125,000/resident/year
- ▶ Funding sources include federal government, state government, grants, hospital support, and clinical revenue generated by attending physicians



Financing

- ▶ Federal government support through Indirect Medical Education/Direct Medical Education funds (IME/DME)
- ▶ IME/DME funds are paid to hospitals and hospitals as the sponsoring institution then “pass through” the funds to residency programs
- ▶ IME/DME payments calculated based on number of residents and Medicare patients
- ▶ Balanced Budget Act of 1997 froze IME/DME funded positions (“Caps”) at 1996 levels




Financing

- ▶ State government supports GME at various levels
- ▶ Idaho currently supports family medicine residency programs at ~\$34,000/resident per year
- ▶ Idaho currently supports the psychiatry residency track at ~10% of the program budget



Financing

- ▶ Clinical revenue varies depending on the specialty
- ▶ Grants available vary depending on the specialty



Idaho GME Programs UW Affiliated

- ▶ Family Medicine Residency
 - Boise – 10 residents/year
 - Caldwell – 2 residents/year
 - Magic Valley – 1 resident/year
 - Pocatello – 6 residents/year
- ▶ Family Medicine Residency Fellowships
 - Sports Medicine – 1 fellow/year
 - HIV Primary Care – 1 fellow/year



Idaho GME Programs

UW Programs

- ▶ Internal Medicine Residency Track
 - Primary Care Track – ten 2nd year residents
 - Preliminary Program – six 1st year residents
- ▶ Pulmonary Fellowship Track – 1 fellow/year
- ▶ Psychiatry Residency Track – 3 residents/year with last two years in Idaho
- ▶ Pediatric Residents – 2 month rotation with six residents/year



Idaho GME Program Planned Expansion

- ▶ Family Medicine Residency in Rexburg
 - Track program of Pocatello with 1 resident/year
 - Accreditation site visit October 2009
 - Accept first resident July 2011



Idaho GME Program Planned Expansion

- ▶ Family Medicine Residency in CDA
 - Track program of Boise with 2 residents/year
 - Accreditation site visit anticipated Spring 2010
 - Accept first residents July 2011
 - Expansion to independent program with 6 residents/year



Idaho GME Program Planned Expansion

- ▶ Internal Medicine
 - Independent, UW program based in Boise with 8 residents/year
 - Accreditation site visit anticipated Spring 2010
 - Accept first residents July 2011
- ▶ Pulmonary Fellowship
 - Independent, UW program based in Boise
 - Accreditation site visit anticipated once Internal Medicine is accredited
