‘Journey to College’ Airs January 26 on IdahoPTV *The Show Will Help Students and Families with the College Application Process*

(Boise). JOURNEY TO COLLEGE, an Idaho Public Television special program sponsored in cooperation with the Idaho State Board of Education, will examine roadblocks to higher education and suggest solutions to help students and parents prepare for their future.

Idaho Public Television's Joan Cartan-Hansen will host this live, 90-minute show Monday, January 26, at 8:00 p.m. MT/PT. She will be joined by a panel of practitioners who will look at efforts across the state to help high school students and their parents prepare for college and other postsecondary programs. They will give practical advice on how to find the right postsecondary program, apply for college, and find the money to pay for it.

During the live broadcast on January 26th, outreach staff from the state's colleges and universities will be available to answer students' and parents' specific questions via a toll-free phone number (1-844-743-7200). Students and parents will be encouraged to call with questions regarding college and other postsecondary education applications, scholarships and completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
