BOARD TO MEET THIS WEEK AT LEWIS-CLARK STATE COLLEGE

(Boise). The Idaho State Board of Education will meet this Wednesday and Thursday, October 19 and 20, 2016, in Lewiston on the campus of Lewis-Clark State College (LCSC). The meetings, which are open to the public, will be held in the Williams Conference Center.

Wednesday's meeting will begin at 10:00 AM (PDT) with LCSC's annual report and a campus tour. A work session will start at 1:00 PM (PDT) with a discussion regarding performance measurement reporting across all levels of public education.

Thursday's meeting will begin at 8:00 AM (PDT). The agenda includes a progress report from the Idaho Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, as well as a report by the STEM Action Center regarding its efforts in promoting STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) education in Idaho. The State Board will also consider authorizing construction and financing of the LCSC Spalding Hall renovation project, as well as consideration of the construction and financing plan for the new Boise State University Fine Arts Building.
