

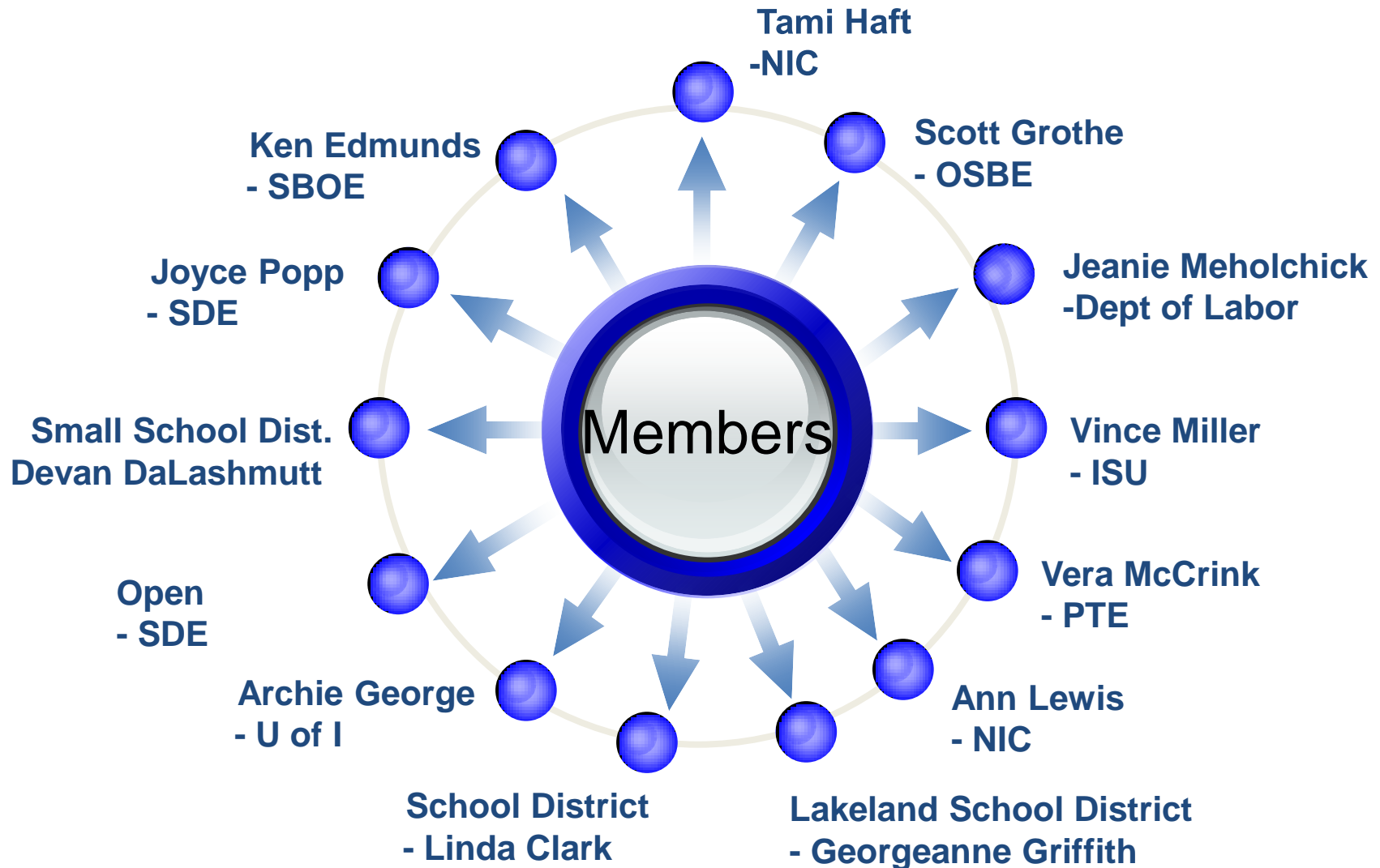

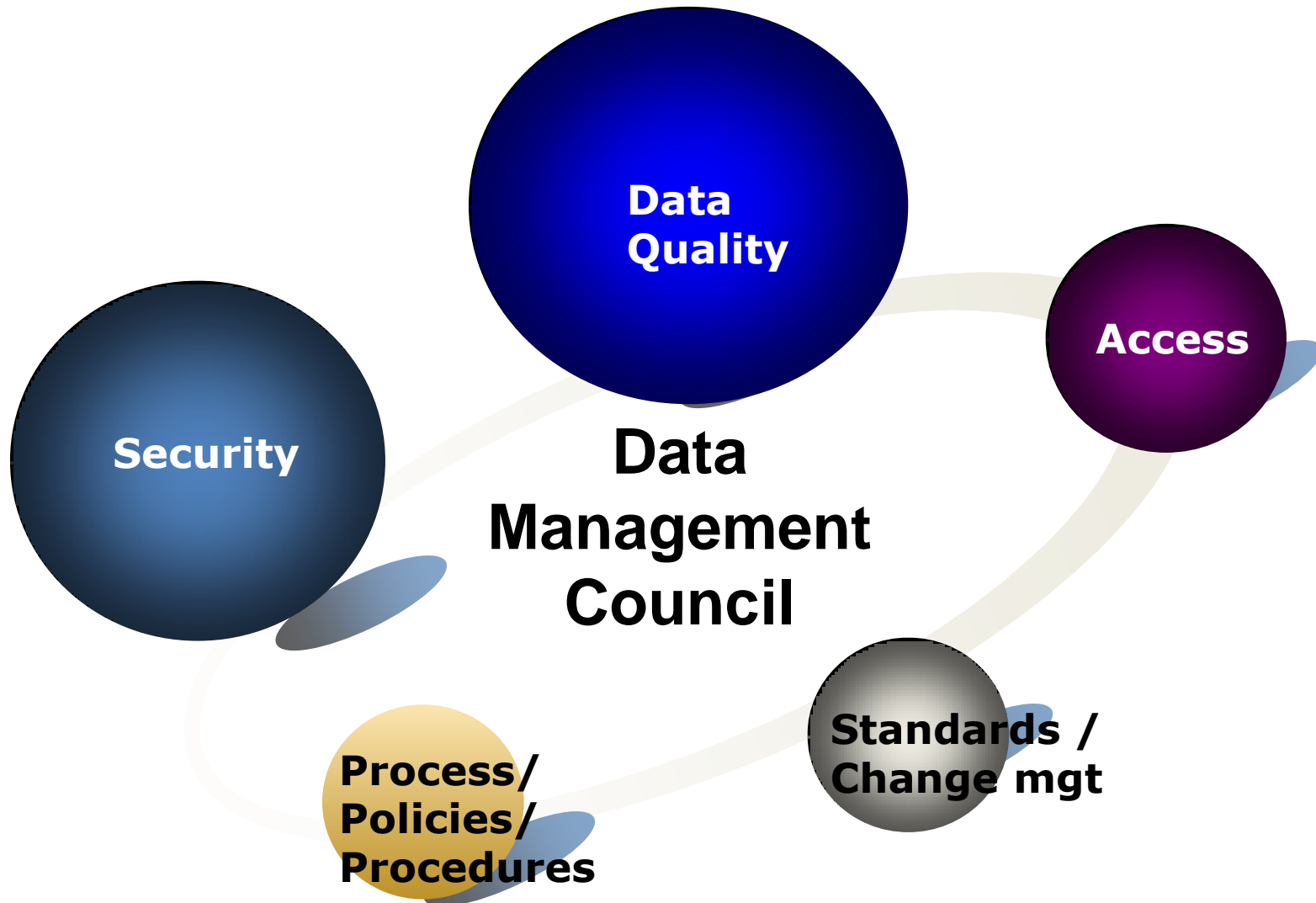


Data Management Council
