SUBJECT

60% College Completion Goal – Data Discussion

REFERENCE

August 2010

The State Board of Education (Board) approved that the State of Idaho's College Completion Goal be for 60% of young Idahoans (ages 25-34) to have a college degree or certificate by 2020.
