STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO MEET THIS WEEK AT BOISE STATE UNIVERSITY

(Boise). The Idaho State Board of Education will meet Wednesday and Thursday, February 15 and 16, 2017, in Boise. The meeting will be held in the Simplot Ballroom of the Student Union Building on the Boise State University (BSU) campus.

The meeting, which is open to the public, is scheduled to begin Wednesday, February 15th at 10:00 AM (MST) with a BSU's annual report and campus tour provided by President Bob Kustra. BSU's annual report and tour will not be broadcast via live streaming over the Internet.

After the campus tour, the Board will resume its meeting at 1:00 PM (MST), Wednesday, at which time live streaming will be available. The agenda includes consideration of an addition to the Anatomy and Physiology Lab Building at the Idaho State University Meridian Health Science Center. Wednesday's meeting will conclude with an executive session.

Thursday's meeting begins at 8:00 AM (MST). The agenda includes an annual report from the Public Charter School Commission. The Board will also receive a report and recommendations resulting from a review of teacher evaluations conducted during the 2015-16 school year.
