BOARD TO MEET THIS WEEK AT IDAHO STATE UNIVERSITY

(Boise). The Idaho State Board of Education will meet this Wednesday and Thursday, August 10 and 11, 2016, in Pocatello on the campus of Idaho State University (ISU). The meetings, which are open to the public, will be held in the Ballroom in the Pond Student Union Building, located at 1065 South 8th Avenue, Building #14.

Wednesday's meeting will begin at 10:00 AM (MDT) with ISU's annual report followed immediately by a campus tour. A work session will start at 1:00 PM (MDT) with a discussion regarding creating education data dashboards to better inform the Board's decision making, and a discussion regarding implementing the Board's strategic plan initiatives relating specifically to higher education.

Thursday's meeting will begin at 8:00 AM (MDT). The agenda includes consideration of a new statewide accountability framework for Idaho public schools. The Board will also review the most recent teacher pipeline report, which documents the number of teachers entering and exiting the teaching profession in Idaho.
