STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO MEET THIS WEEK AT UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO

(Boise). The Idaho State Board of Education will meet this Wednesday and Thursday, April 19 and 20, 2017, in Moscow on the campus of the University of Idaho. The meetings, which are open to the public, will be held in the International Ballroom in the Bruce M. Pitman Center.

Wednesday's meeting will start at 10:00 AM (PDT) with the University of Idaho annual report and campus tour. Wednesday afternoon, the Board will set tuition and fees for the 2017-2018 academic year for Boise State University, Eastern Idaho Technical College, Idaho State University, Lewis-Clark State College and the University of Idaho. Thursday's meeting will begin at 8:00 AM (PDT). The agenda includes a presentation by representatives of the Coeur d'Alene tribe discussing their successes in developing a comprehensive education pipeline for students starting in early childhood and ending with graduate and professional degrees. The Board will also discuss work being done to develop a consistent definition of "college and career ready" that applies to both education and labor.
