STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO MEET THIS WEEK AT BOISE STATE UNIVERSITY

(Boise). The Idaho State Board of Education will meet this Wednesday and Thursday, May 17 and 18, 2017, in Boise on the campus of Boise State University in the Stueckle Sky Center.

Wednesday's meeting will start at 9:00 AM (MDT) with a Board work session to discuss possible initiatives for inclusion in its fiscal year 2019 budget request, and strategies for communicating the importance of higher education to the state. At 11:00 AM (MDT) Wednesday, the Board will go into executive session to conduct annual performance evaluations of the presidents of Boise State University, Eastern Idaho Technical College, Idaho State University, Lewis-Clark State College and the University of Idaho, and the executive director of the Board. The Board will meet in executive session again on Thursday at 8:00 AM (MDT) to complete the annual performance evaluations. Executive sessions are not open to the public.
