



Status of Online Programming

- Boise State offers over 30 degrees and certificates fully online.
- Last year we had 3,333 students enrolled exclusively online. These tend to be nontraditional-aged working adults.
- We also had an additional 8,725 students taking one or more online courses as part of their semester load. Many of these students were traditional-aged, campus-based students. Boise State students can choose from 426 courses that are offered fully online.

Objectives of Online Program Initiative

Launched in 2015

- ✓ Develop and launch 12-15 in-demand degree and certificate programs in the next five years so working adults from across Idaho and beyond can advance their career goals by taking courses anytime and anywhere.
- ✓ Incorporate best practices in online development and teaching by deploying a multi-expert team that comes alongside an academic department and guides and assists them in planning, developing, and launching their online courses.
- ✓ Provide fully online students with the unique support services they need to succeed and to complete their program.
- ✓ Develop a business model that allows for these new online programs and services to proceed without new State funds.

New Approaches Being Incorporated into Boise State's Online Initiative

- New ways of engaging students and deepening the learning experience
- Enhanced academic calendar (6 entry points per year)
- Increased utilization of learning analytics
- Increased use of open educational resources
- Increased use of credit for prior learning and stackable credentialing
