## **STATE BOARD TO MEET THIS WEEK AT LEWIS-CLARK STATE COLLEGE**

(Boise). The Idaho State Board of Education will meet this Wednesday and Thursday, October 18 and 19, 2017, in Lewiston on the campus of Lewis-Clark State College. The meetings, which are open to the public, will be held in the Williams Conference Center.

At 11:00 AM (PDT), Wednesday, the State Board meeting will begin with an annual report by Lewis-Clark State College administration. For Wednesday's work session, the State Board will review performance measure reports showing outcomes of several important indices within Idaho's kindergarten through college public education system. Reports will include a statewide review of college entrance exam results and student performance on the Idaho Reading Indicator.

The State Board will convene again Thursday morning at 8:00 AM (PDT). Highlights of the agenda include consideration of approval to proceed with the planning and design phase for the University of Idaho Nancy M. Cummings Research, Extension, and Education Center (NMCREEC) classroom and office facility in Salmon, Idaho. The State Board will also consider approval of a new, online program through Boise State University that awards a Master of Science in Genetic Counseling.
