STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION ANNOUNCES SEARCH PROCESS FOR BOISE STATE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT REVISED

(Boise). Idaho State Board of Education President Dr. Linda Clark has announced the search process for selecting the next President of Boise State University. The national search will begin in January 2018 and end with a final selection by the end of May 2018. The new President will succeed current BSU President Bob Kustra, who announced in November that he will retire effective June 30, 2018, following 15 years in the presidency.

"Boise State University has become the largest university in the state and a driving force in helping to meet the workforce needs of the Treasure Valley and the state. It will be incumbent upon this search committee to find a leader who is able to sustain and build upon that momentum," said Dr. Clark.

The State Board will use <u>AGB Search</u>, a national firm that specializes in higher education executive search, to assist with the process. In addition to support from AGB Search, the State Board will rely on a local search committee to make a recommendation of final candidates, from which the State Board will make its selection. Dr. Clark will chair the search committee and be joined by fellow State Board member Dr. David Hill. The search committee membership will be composed of the following State Board, university and community representatives.

Several milestones mark the five-month search process:

January 17-19, 2018: AGB search consultants will hold several in-person listening sessions with BSU stakeholder groups to hear input regarding the qualities and characteristics that should be included in the job description and announcement. Specific times and locations are being finalized and will be announced.

February 5, 2018: The search will be opened, and candidates will be able to submit materials. Employment postings developed with input from the listening sessions will be published nationally.

March 12, 2018: The application process will be closed. The search committee will review all applicant qualifications and select a candidate group for initial interviews in March.

March-April 2018: After initial interviews, the candidate pool will be reduced and due diligence completed on the remaining candidates. Campus visits will be scheduled for candidates, followed by a recommendation of finalist candidates for the State Board to consider.

May 2018: The State Board will interview finalist candidates and make a selection.
