BOARD TO MEET ON MARCH 8

The Idaho State Board of Education will hold a special meeting on Thursday, March 8, 2018 at 10am (MST).

The meeting will be held via teleconference, which will originate from the Board office at 650 W. State Street, third floor in Boise.

The Board will consider for approval a proposal to construct two new research facilities – a Collaborative Computing Center and a Cybercore Integration Center – to be located at the Board’s research campus in Idaho Falls. In 2017, the Idaho Legislature authorized the Board and the Idaho State Building Authority to enter into agreements to provide for the financing and development of the facilities.

Once built, the Board will sublease the facilities to Battelle Energy Alliance, LLC - the principal operating contractor at the Idaho National Laboratory (INL). The facilities would provide opportunities for collaboration in research and education among higher education institutions and the INL.
