FIRM NAMED TO LEAD PRESIDENT SEARCH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO

The Idaho State Board of Education today announced that the firm Storbeck Pimentel & Associates will lead the search for the next president of the University of Idaho.

Storbeck Pimentel specializes in conducting executive searches in the education and nonprofit sectors. Storbeck Pimentel was selected from a list of eight firms that submitted proposals.

Board Members Emma Atchley and Don Soltman will serve on a screening committee that will vet candidates, with Atchley serving as committee chair. Makeup of the rest of the screening committee will be decided by Atchley and Soltman in consultation with members of the U of I campus community. That process will begin immediately.

“I appreciate the Board’s confidence in allowing me to help lead this search for the University of Idaho’s 19th president,” Atchley said. “I look forward to assembling the members of the screening committee and working with them to develop a transparent process that will include input from Vandal students, faculty, staff and alumni.”

The Board plans to name a new president sometime early next year and have that person in place on the Moscow campus by the beginning of the fiscal year, July 1, 2019.

Storbeck Pimentel & Associates will be paid \$78,400 plus out-of-pocket expenses.
