



IDAHO ADMINISTRATOR RENEWAL OF PRACTICE: 3 MODULES FOR ADMINISTRATORS

The Idaho Administrator Renewal of Practice course is comprised of three online modules and meets requirements of the Career Ladder legislation passed in 2015 (H296), Idaho Code §33-1204. Completion of all three modules satisfies criteria for administrative recertification.

Course modules include:

- Professional Practice and the Danielson Framework
- Assessment Literacy
- Effective Supervision of Staff: Inclusive Leadership

Each module takes two weeks to complete and includes five lessons. The administrators participating in this course will recognize rater-reliability in evaluation, gain a deeper level of understanding for professional practice in Idaho's Evaluation process, review student achievement and growth through assessment literacy and gain insight through a deeper understanding of inclusive leadership.

- There are three date options to register for this professional development opportunity. The course runs for approximately six weeks and completion of all three modules within the session of your choice is worth three professional development credits, which will be provided by the Idaho State Board of Education. Additionally, the required text book will be provided to each participant as an eBook. (*10 Mindframes for Visible Learning Teaching for Success, John Hattie & Klaus Zierer*)
