The Idaho State Board of Education will meet via teleconference on Wednesday, December 18, 2019 starting at 9 a.m. MST.

The teleconference will originate from the Board office located on the third floor of Len B. Jordan Building at 650 W. State Street in Boise.

Agenda items include:

- An update on the development of a military “crosswalk” enabling military veterans to earn college credit for specialized training received while in the service by aligning those training elements with requirements for college-level general education in math, English, science, oral communication, arts and humanities and social sciences.
- An update from the Division of Career Technical Education on plans to gather public input on how to use federal Perkins V funds to benefit CTE programs statewide.

- The Board will also consider capital building projects at Idaho State University and the University of Idaho.
