1. Approval of minutes (action item)

2. Mark Browning data request (action item)

Mark Browning, Vice President for College Relations, College of Western Idaho has requested CWI dual credit data specific to one unnamed Idaho high school (School X). He has requested us to work with the CWI IR office to build a dataset of students graduating from School X who take dual credit through CWI and provide high school GPA, dual credit GPA, fall immediate go on rates, and an indicator for whether or not the student went on to a 2 year or 4 year institution. He would like this data from FY15 through FY19. He is doing this on behalf of his institution so does have a FERPA exception.

Dianna shared that she received a similar request for NIC. She would like this type of data to be provided on a regular basis to all colleges in a consistent manner. Cathleen shared that she is working on this project with Institutional Research. Chris shared that we could use this request as a pilot for a statewide approach.
