The Idaho State Board of Education will hold a regular Board meeting on Wednesday, June 10, 2020 starting at 9 a.m. (MDT)

Agenda items include:

- Discussions about several items pertaining to K-12 accountability, assessments, and graduation requirements including:
 - The Board's Accountability Oversight Committee's annual report on the state accountability system
 - The senior math requirement
 - The 10th grade Idaho Standards Achievement Test (ISAT) and what assessments should be used for accountability at the high school level

- Partial waivers of State Board requirements to help institutions and career technical programs respond to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Board will also act on the use of \$4.8 million in CARES Act funding reserved for State Education Agencies to help mitigate the impact of the pandemic.
