**BOARD TO CONSIDER “STAY HEALTHY” RESOLUTION  
DURING SPECIAL MEETING**

The Idaho State Board of Education has scheduled a virtual special Board meeting on Thursday, December 10, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. (MST).

The purpose of the meeting is to consider a resolution intended to protect student health and continued in-person instruction at Idaho public schools.

The proposed Board resolution includes a directive clarifying expectations of school district leaders to follow protocols outlined in Governor Brad Little’s modified Stage 2 Stay Healthy Order issued last month, which prohibits gatherings of more than 10 people, both public and private, whether indoors or outdoors, and mandates that physical distancing be followed at gatherings which are permissible. This includes school athletic events.
