1. Approval of minutes (action item)

- a. DMC_Meeting_Minutes_09_15_2020.docx
- b. Update 08 2020 minutes to note that Voc Rehab had requested “unredacted” data:

Marcia and Scott moved to approve the August and September minutes with a modification to the August minutes (unredacted data). Both approved unanimously.

2. Andrew Scheef data request followup – action item

Dr. Scheef requested these components as the numerator and not just the total.

- A) Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school
- B) Enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school
- C) Enrolled in higher education or in some other postsecondary education or training program, or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school.

Tami and Scott moved to approve the data request. Data request was approved unanimously.

3. Update to Voc Rehab data request - action item

- a. Percent of students with a disability 9-12 who are CTE concentrators by LEA
- b. Number of SkillStack® badges earned by students with disabilities in comparison to those earned by non-disabled peers by LEA

OSBE met with Voc Rehab and will sign an MOU. Grace and Tami moved to approve the additional data requested by Voc Rehab. Data request was approved unanimously.

4. U.S. World & News Report Rankings – information item

6. Boise State data request - information item

We had previously discussed a data request from Dr. Heather Williams but the DMC had some questions about the project. COVID interrupted the project so Dr. Williams is just getting back to it. Dr. Williams would like unredacted 3rd grade ELA and 8th grade Math district ISAT data. Beyond that, I will gather the following data from Dr. Williams:

Detailed description of project for MOU:

This project examines whether or not there is a link between student achievement on standardized tests and teacher retention. Teacher retention rates were provided by the State Department of Education. The researcher is requesting unredacted 3rd grade ELA ISAT proficiency rates and unredacted 8th grade Math ISAT proficiency rates for the 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years. A standard data sharing MOU is in the process of being signed.
