**ATTENDANCE PLAN RELEASED FOR INTERCOLLEGIATE
ATHLETIC EVENTS**

The executive director of the Idaho State Board of Education, in consultation with the Governor's office, today released a plan for attendance at indoor athletic events at Idaho's public four-year college and universities for the remainder of the 2020-21 winter sport school year.

Institutions may permit up to 40-percent capacity in their facilities, or up to four spectators per student participant, whichever is larger, if physical distancing requirements can be maintained or if masks are worn. The plan is consistent with Idaho Stage 3 Stay Healthy Guidelines.

Student spectators will count against the 40-percent capacity.

Coaches, participating athletes, band, cheerleaders, and dance teams are excluded from determining gym capacity.

The plan mirrors similar guidance created for high school activities and athletic events earlier this year.
