# Who to Report - Special Education



LEA must report **ALL** students – ages 3-21 who

- Received written consent for initial evaluation
- Regardless of determination status

LEAs may have a single record on the Sped file for each student

Who enters and exits during the school year

# Who Counts?



- All disability categories;
  - Speech/Language Impairment;
- All grade levels (PK – 12, and NG);
  - **PK** regardless of service location;
  - Kindergarten (**KG**) age eligible
  - Grade **12** may include students participating in secondary transition services;
  - **NG** – Private school students on a service plan

# What is Child Count?



Annual report of students receiving special education and related services. The data captures a snapshot on the first Friday in November (Nov. 4, 2022) of students who have;

- An active individual education program (IEP) or service plan
- Active services



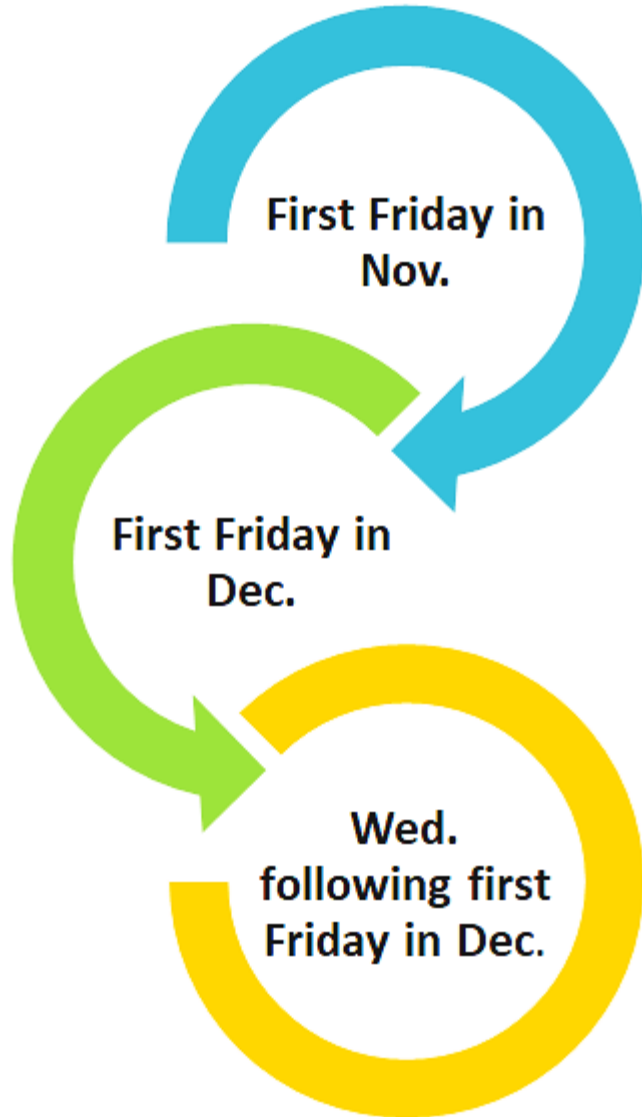


# Child Find – 60-day Timeline



- Child Find or 60-day timeline reporting is required for all initial eligibility determinations including students transitioning from the Infant Toddler Program.

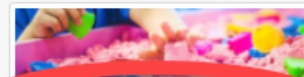

# Sped Data Elements



- **idStuID - Idaho State Student ID (EDUID)**
- **resSchoolID - Resident School ID** – school responsible for primary education - **state assigned number**
- **servSchoolID - Service School ID** – school responsible for SPED services - **state assigned number**

# Sped Data Elements (2)



- **Exceptionality1 - Primary disability category**
- **Environment** – this is a change
  - Early Childhood - age 3-5 not Kindergarten age eligible (44-52)
  - School Age – age 5 Kindergarten age eligible through age-21 (01-21)
  - If the reported environment is inappropriate for the students age the student will be excluded from child count

# Sped Data - Early Childhood Transition



## Referred by Health and Welfare

- **ECReferredDhw** - Early Childhood Referred by DHW - yes or no
- **ECDecTim** - EC Eligibility Decision Timeliness – by 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday?
  - IDspedDate and IEPDate must be by 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday
- **ECDecLate** - Eligibility Determination was late – how many days
- **ECLateRea** – Eligibility Determination late reason – why
- **ECLROther** – Late Reason of “other” explanation



# Sped Data – Dates, Dates, Dates



- **IDSpedDate** - **Initial Determination Date** – date that team comes to consensus on **initial** eligibility, whether eligible or not
- **SEEntryDate** – **Program Entry Date** - in **current year**
- **IEPDate** - **Active IEP meeting Date** (**current** IEP) should be updated every year
- **consentDate** – **Initial consent Date**
  - **Only required** if IDSpedDate is in current year

# Sped Data – 60 Day Timeline



- **60DTline - 60-timeline**

- Was initial eligibility determined within 60 calendar days of receipt of parental consent
- The Yes or No response is not a compliance determination
- Required only if IDSpedDate in current year (the day after last year ends)

- **DaysLate - Days late** – How many days beyond 60 calendar days?

- **LDRea - Late Determination Reason**

- AA Additional Assessment(s) needed
- EM Extended Medical Issues
- SD Scheduling Difficulties
- **SE State Exception Rule**
- SM Student moved into district with written extension request
- ST Staffing Issues
- WE Written Extension

# Sped Data – State Exception Rule



- **State Exception Rule** – regular school not in session for 5 or more consecutive days
- **ExRule** - **If late due to state exception rule**
  - AN Acts of Nature Fire, Snow, Communicable Illness
  - HB Holiday Break Thanksgiving, Winter Break
  - OB Other School Break Harvest Break, Hunting, etc.
  - SB Spring Break Spring Break period
  - SM Summer Break Summer Break period

# Sped Data – Coding State Exception Rule



- When using state exception code this way
  - 60DTline = N
  - DaysLate = however many
  - LDRea = SE
  - ExRule = whichever apply

# Sped Data Elements



- **SpedEligible – Sped Eligibility** – from most recent evaluation
  - N – No Eligible
  - U – Undetermined – **initial eligibility only**
  - E – Eligible
- **UndetRea - Undetermined Reason**
  - MO Moved out of district
  - SD student is deceased
  - WD withdrawn by parent

# Sped Data Elements cont.



- **SEStatus – Special Ed Status**
  - A- Active
  - I – Inactive
  - T – Tested–Ineligible – **initial eligibility only**
- **SEExitDate – date left** for the current year – **required!**
- **SEExitReason** – from option sets
- **Case manager** – EDUID



# Sped Data Elements (cont. 3)



End of year – **exit all students from Sped file**

- **SpedEligible** = E - Eligible
- **SEExitDate** = should be less than or equal to the District Exit
- **SEExitReason** =
  - 12-Summer Break
    - **SEStatus** = I-Inactive

# Grade Levels Issues – Student Demo File



NG grade level is for **age 3-21** private - SPED services only. These students are actually receiving services through a service plan.

- NG = P (Private)
  - School age (KG age eligible – 21)
    - Environment 21 – Parentally Placed in Private School
  - Early Childhood (age 3-5 not KG age eligible)
    - Environment determine using Decision Tree
- Students in 18-21 program = Grade 12 until they graduate or age out



# Summer Reporting



- Sped information is not necessary in Summer Alt uploads – can submit just the headers
- If a Sped Student graduates through a Summer Alt program the Program Exit information must be updated in the June ISEE upload.
- If working with students in summer through ESY this is identified by the 10- ESY Extended School Year exit code in your June upload



# Service Plan



- The below coding is for private school students who are receiving **only** special education and related services (Proportionate Share).
- Grade Level = NG
- PhSchool= P – Private
- School-age environment = 21
  - Parentally Placed in a Private School
- Early Childhood environment = see decision tree
- Courses and attendance are not required



## **Do not exit student from district/charter**

1. Exit the student from the School
2. Re-enroll in School entry (or create new school entry)
  - Grade level = list current grade level
  - Add course to address IEP goals and services
  - Switch to the DR calendar (if less than 150 minutes per day)
3. Update Special Education data
  - Environment = 11 (Separate School)

# Who counts ISDB Campus Students?



**Idaho School for the Deaf and the Blind** reports students receiving education services at the ISDB campus.

- Residential
- Day School
- Sending districts do not report these students at all

# Who Counts ISDB Outreach Students?



- The reports local education agency (LEA) reports students receiving outreach services through the Idaho Bureau of Educational Services for the Deaf and the Blind (IBESDB).
- Itinerant services
- Onsite services
- Regional Services
- IBESDB Regional Preschools (does not include PK on ISDB campus)

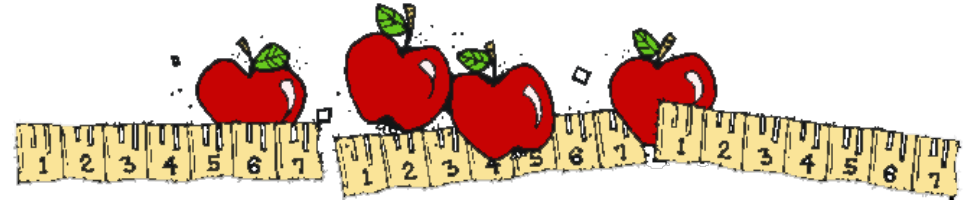

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# Correct Warnings when possible



**Warning R113933:** Mismatch of IDSpedDate, consentDate, and 60DTline

- IDSpedDate is 69 days after ConsentDate. Therefore 60DTline should be N.

- If SEExitDate is before 5/1/2020, then SEExitReason cannot be 12 (Summer Break)

**Warning R113910:** SEEntryDate before entry into district
