

E-rate and State Funding Cheat Sheet Idaho School Districts and Charter Schools

GETTING STARTED	Discuss your infrastructure needs with your team. When does our current Internet contract end? Do we need any new hardware or infrastructure? What is the estimated value of the contract we'll procure? If between \$75K - 150L, then section 1 of Idaho 67-2806 applies. If greater than \$150K, then a sealed bidding process is required (section 2 of Idaho 67-2906)
STEP 1	File FCC Form 470 to request for new service bids
July 1 - Dec 31	 A Request For Proposals (RFP) is always recommended Min. 28-day bidding window required. Recommended minimum: 45-days for smaller projects, 60-days for fiber construction If you intend to apply for the B.I.I.G. infrastructure grant, first contact broadband@sde.idaho.gov to discuss.
	October 28: Deadline to claim E-rate funding from previous year
	November: : submit current year invoices to Broadband Program for reimbursement (July – December) Update E-rate profile with Nov enrollment/NSLP data before cutoff.
STEP 2	File FCC Form 471 Window to receive funding commitments for upcoming
	school year.
Jan 1 - March 31	 Application window usually opens mid-January and closes mid-March. NEW SERVICES: If you are transitioning to a new service, we highly advise filing a second 471 that continues your existing service in case
	there is a delay. Respond to E-rate application review requests.
	(SDE) Submit signed copy of new or updated contract(s) to <u>SDE</u> for upcoming year reimbursements.
STEP 3	Receive Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL)
April 1 - June 30	 Applicants can safely order internal connection components and work on the internet service transition.
	File FCC Form 486 to confirm the Service Start Date of the funded services or hardware. This counts as the installation date, or "turn-on" date to confirm when billing begins.
	(SDE) Submit current-year invoices to SDE for reimbursement (January - June)
	NEW SERVICES: Send SDE updated public IP address tech services
