The Idaho State Board of Education will hold its December regular Board meeting on Wednesday, December 13, 2023 starting at 10:00 a.m. (Mountain Time).

Agenda items include:

• Consider proposals by the College of Eastern Idaho to offer two Bachelor of Applied Science degrees in operations management and in digital forensics and analytics.

- Consider a request by the College of Western Idaho to offer a Bachelor of Applied Science degree in business administration.
- Consider a request by Boise State University to begin the planning and design phase for a new science building on campus.
- Consider Registered Teacher Apprenticeship Program standards.
- The Board will also hear the latest Educator Pipeline Report, which covers recruitment and retention of educators working in Idaho's K-12 public education system.
