BOARD TO MEET NEXT WEEK AT BOISE STATE

The Idaho State Board of Education will hold its February regular Board meeting on February 27-28, 2024, in the Student Union Building's Simplot Ballroom at Boise State University.

The meeting starts on Tuesday, February 27 at 10:30 a.m. Mountain Time and on Wednesday, February 28 at 10:00 a.m. Mountain Time, and will be carried via Boise State's livestream: <u>https://www.boisestate.edu/btv/idaho-state-board-of-education-2024-february/</u>

Agenda Items include:

- Consider recommendations to improve math instruction and performance of middle grade students (grades 5-9).
- Work Session to hear and discuss recommendations of a Board working group regarding Board Policy III.Z., which governs planning, alignment, and coordination of academic and career technical education programs at all eight public postsecondary institutions. The recommendations relate to the

way in which planning, and delivery of postsecondary programs could be improved to better meet the needs of all Idahoans.

- Hear a recommendation from the Board's Accountability Oversight Committee that would focus on the trajectory of student growth in various subjects and how to improve on growth rather than just determining whether a student is proficient or not.
- Hear from Idaho's Teacher of the Year Trent Van Leuven.

Boise State students and employees will also have an opportunity to participate in an Open Forum discussion with the Board on various topics related to their interests, and experiences attending classes and working at Boise State University.
