BOARD TO MEET NEXT WEEK IN POCATELLO

The Idaho State Board of Education will hold a regular Board meeting June 11-13, 2024 at the ICCU Bengal Alumni Center on the campus of Idaho State University in Pocatello.

On Tuesday June 11, 2024, the Board will go into executive session immediately after opening the meeting at 9 a.m. Mountain Time to conduct performance evaluations of the presidents of Idaho's public four-year institutions and the Board's executive director.

Agenda items include:

- Consider data and recommendations requested by the Board and developed by the Idaho Department of Education and Board staff to establish a

minimum number of instructional days for schools, as required by provisions established in H.B. 521 signed into law earlier this year by Governor Brad Little.

- Consider new program proposals put forward by the University of Idaho and Boise State University.
- Consider nearly a half-dozen legislative ideas for the 2025 legislative session. Ideas approved by the Board will be sent to the Governor's office for consideration.
- The Board will also consider increasing spending caps for athletics at all four institutions, as well as several contracts and contract extensions for athletic personnel.

Because the meeting is being held in Pocatello, the Board will sit as the Board of Trustees for Idaho State University and students, faculty and staff have time allotted to address the Trustees. ISU President Robert Wagner will also present the institution's annual report, his first since he was named president late last year.
