## **BOARD TO MEET THIS WEEK**

The Idaho State Board of Education will hold its regular December Board meeting on Wednesday, December 18, 2024 starting at 9 a.m. Mountain Time at the Board office in downtown Boise.

Immediately after convening, the Board will go into executive session. No action will be taken in executive session.

Pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206(1)(f) “To communicate with legal counsel for the public agency to discuss the legal ramifications of and legal options for pending litigation, or controversies not yet being litigated but imminently likely to be litigated.”

After the executive session, the Board will come back into open session for the remainder of the meeting.

Other agenda items include:

- Consider three Board resolutions relating to DEI Ideology, Governance, and Freedom of Expression in higher education. All three have been revised based on input received from students, institutional leaders, faculty, staff, and the general public since the Board first considered the resolutions in November.
- Consider a request by Mountain View School District in Idaho County to divide the district into two separate school districts. If approved by the Board, the proposal would go before Idaho County voters in May.
- Consider a request by Boise State University to approve new contracts for Boise State's athletic director, head softball coach and head women's basketball coach.
- Consider a request by Idaho State University to sell the Magnuson Alumni House located near the Pocatello campus.
- The Board will also hear a report on the Empowering Parents program, the annual report from the Idaho Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, and the annual report Idaho's Educator Pipeline (teacher recruitment and retention).
