3. Kathryn Hill (SDE) – Labor Data for Post-School Outcomes (action item)

I'd like to put an item on the agenda for the Labor Data request from Kathryn Hill (SDE) — it is for the Indicator 14 Post-School Outcomes — federally mandated. They don't get back labor detail, but get the answers to these questions:

- Did former students participate in the workforce after exiting secondary school?
- Did former students who participated in the workforce work;
- full-time or less than full time;
- 90 days or more; (combined across employers);
- with an average income of minimum wage?
- If they are working full time (combined across employers) suggest proxying full-time as minimum wage * 160 = \$1,160 - if they make at least that amount then label as employed_full_time. If they make wages, but less than full-time, then label as employed_part_time.
- Please look at two quarters and four quarters after the date specified.

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• Data period June 1, 2023, through September 1, 2024.

We used to run this for Alisa Fewkes – Kathryn Hill replaced her.

Labor and DMC need to approve the request. Moved (Scott W and Wes) and approved – allowable use of data

4. DMC Exception – ACGR (action item)

Date:	December 1, 2017
Exception:	Four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate (ACGR) doesn't need to be masked at the school level. Normal masking rules are followed when ACGR is broken down in any way.
