BOARD TO MEET THIS WEEK IN MOSCOW

The Idaho State Board of Education will hold a regular Board meeting on Wednesday and Thursday, April 16 -17, 2025, at the Bruce M. Pitman Center on the University of Idaho campus in Moscow.

The meeting will start at 9 a.m. Pacific Time both days.

Agenda items include:

- Consider a request to change the name of Lewis-Clark State College to Lewis-Clark State University. If authorized by the Board, the proposal would be submitted to the Legislature for consideration.

- Hear an update on progress made on the Boise State president search.
- Newly appointed Board President Kurt Liebich will select Board members to serve with him on the Board's Executive Committee as vice president and secretary.

Because the meeting will occur in Moscow, the Board will be sitting as the Board of Regents for the University of Idaho. U of I President C. Scott Green will present the university's annual report and time will be allotted for students, faculty and staff to address the Board of Regents.

The State Board of Education was established in the Idaho Constitution and is charged with general supervision and governance of Idaho's public higher education institutions and the public school system.
